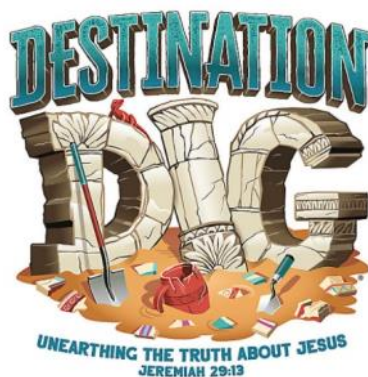

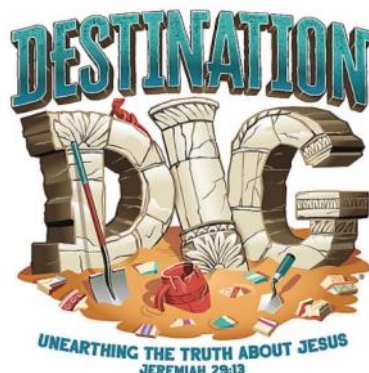
Nursery Workers Needed
