It has been said that the Sunday School stands as the creative center from which all of the organizations of the church are fed and strengthened. As begin our new church year, we need to remind ourselves of the importance of coming to Sunday School. If you haven't been attending Sunday School, I ask you to consider joining a class.

As we study the Word we become Christians who are mature, balanced, complete, and ready to serve God.

Sunday School Also helps us exalt the Savior. Usually we think of exalting the savior as a part of worship. But where does a person first learn how to concentrate on spiritual truths and express his love for God? It is in the small groups of Sunday School classes that children, youth, and adults are taught the "how to's" of worship.

Let's recommit ourselves to our Sunday School. It will be only as strong as we make it. We need to pray for it, join it, attend it, and work in it! Commit yourself to bringing people to Sunday School every week. Not only is it an easy things to do, but it may change their life!

Access the church Directory and member information in record time! Log on to "Member to Member" from our web site OR download the free ACS Church Life app to your smart phone!

I'm sure some of you are asking why the church secretary is pushing all this online and digital STUFF at us...

Like it or not, this 'stuff' is the world we live in. In a recent training session I attended, we were reminded that young adults (and some of us older ones, too!) do EVERYTHING from their smart phones or tablets. Literally, everything! We communicate, make doctor appointments, pay bills, deposit funds to our bank accounts...I can check the mechanical status of my car (oil life, tire pressure), lock/unlock and even start up my car while inside the office - all from my iPhone! Young adults do not write checks. In fact, our account representative at First Famers' told me this week that new account holders do not even order checks!

So, the church is working to adapt to the new ways of communicating and giving - thus, the Church Life App. This is a FREE app for your phone.

Search your app store for "ACS Church Life" (Google Play for Android or Apple App Store for iPhone). Once you have the app installed, you **log in** simply using the same user name and password you use to sign in to **Member to Member** on the church web site. If you have difficulty with either the web site or the app, call or stop by the church office during the week and I will do my best to get you up and running.

Some great features of the App...

- You can make a contribution to the church
- Look up phone numbers, addresses, and emails for our church family
- Send a text or call a member while viewing their information in the app.
- Pull up directions and a map for home visits.


