Reimbursements: Many times, teachers will purchase items for their particular class or activity on their own and then present the receipts to the church office for reimbursement. Please be sure that you turn in the receipts within 30 days of your purchase. If you order your own materials please provide the office a copy Sign your name and why the purchase was made on the receipt and leave it in the box on the office door. Please note that the church *does not* reimburse sales tax. We are tax exempt and are registered or have accounts with many businesses in the area. Check with the church office if you have questions about your purchase.

Ordering Materials: materials online is to call the office. The church has a tax exempt Amazon Prime account, and Amazon knows where to ship our order so that we receive it. Email your order to the church and I will be happy to purchase the items for you and notify you when Blessings...

they arrive.

We are now in a new church year with new leadership and the Shipping: We also have difficulty with vendors shipping via beginnings of our fall programs. With the new year and new USPS to our street address OR via UPS to our PO Box. If that leadership comes a reminder of some procedures. 
