Songs like "it's the Most Wonderful Time of the Yes," "Have a Holly Jolly Christmas," "Chestnuts Roasting on an Open Fire," "Jingle Bells," and "Walking in a Winter Wonderland" all communicate loud and clear that Christmas time is to be a joyous season. Disillusionment at Christmas is not an unusual thing. We get so hyped up with expectations about what Christmas is supposed to be that often the real thing doesn't measure up, and we are disappointed. What can you do this Christmas to avoid disillusionment? How can you improve your level of joy this Christmas?

The problem is not Christmas. It is in our expectations. We are looking for the wrong thing. What we need to be looking for and expecting this Christmas season is an experience of worship, a fresh glimpse of Him who was born King of the Jews. If our goal this Christmas is to worship Jesus, then I doubt very seriously we will be dissatisfied with our experience. I promise you, when you look for the right thing you will have joy at Christmas.


