If you are a Christian the Bible teaches that you are indwelt by the Holy Spirit. You'd be surprised what God will do in your life in 2017 if you won't quench the Holy Spirit. So He's saying, "Be useful, and let the Holy Spirit control your life."

Have you allowed the Holy Spirit to take control of your life?

The Church will grow or diminish based on the active work of the Holy Spirit as He flows through the people of God to accomplish the will of God on earth. I'm going to ask you to yield your life to Him and say, "Holy Spirit, take control of my life; fill me and use me in 2017." I believe that if we would all pray that prayer and mean it that the blessings that God will pour out upon us in 2017 will be too numerous to imagine. Let's allow the Holy Spirit to work in and through us so that we can see the church grow through the coming year!
